

FIELD REPORT

A team of scientists from ICAR-CAFRI Jhansi visited the Khailar village in Jhansi district of Uttar Pradesh, on the request of a farmer i.e. Mr. Arvind Singh Yadav. He has nine acre of sloppy land, out of which is two acre is under mixed cropping system of wheat and mustard and rest of the land is barren. Apart from this, he has good source of irrigation from well, most of the farm is protected from stone fence and few under agroforestry tree based live fence. He expressed his interest to convert his farm into agroforestry based model to get round the year production and income. Soil and water samples were also collected from his farm to check soil and water quality, so that suitable crops can be planned. Seeing the potentiality of the land, director CAFRI assured technical solutions to sustainable agroforestry model in his farm in the coming years which can be serve as a model for other farmers of that area. Such interventions of CAFRI in farmer's field will help to upscale agroforestry
