

**ICAR-CAFRI Jhansi received first rank in mid-term review grading of
Network Project on “Harvesting, Processing and Value Addition of Natural Resins and Gums”**

ICAR-Central Agroforestry Research Institute (CAFRI), Jhansi is one of the 10 implementing centres of ICAR Network Project on “Harvesting, Processing and Value Addition of Natural Resins and Gums” coordinated by ICAR-Indian Institute of Natural Resins and Gums (IINRG), Ranchi since inception of the project in 2008. The mandate for ICAR-CAFRI, Jhansi is Development of agroforestry models based on gum and resin yielding trees for livelihood security, sustainability and horizontal dissemination of technologies with *Acacia senegal*, *Acacia nilotica* and *Butea monosperma* as the target species. The mid-term review of the project was carried out in 2020 and the report compiled by the Project Coordinator, ICAR- IINRG, Ranchi revealed that **ICAR-CAFRI to be the front runner with full marks in all the performance indicators and eventually graded #1 amongst the network partners.**
